Principal's Message

As a father with 3 sons at school, I understand firsthand the challenges of trying to guide our kids back into a routine. I ask families to please keep this focus and effort up. To provide the best opportunity for our kids, it is very important they are strongly encouraged to be at school, on time, every day. The more your child is at school, the more they learn and the more they will be able to connect positively with others. By involving our kids in the value routine to engage at school, we are supporting them with a very strong life lessons — that all success comes from practice, dedication and consistent effort over time.

This extremely important initiative lead by Mr Sterling and Mrs Wilson supports and leads our beginning teachers across the entire network to ensure our students have the best equipped quality teachers in their classrooms. Parents and Citizens Meeting

It was wonderful to meet with so many parents at our last P&C meeting. Thank you for the warm welcome, enthusiasm, and support. P&C Meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month at school at 2p.m. All parents and carers are welcome to attend. The P&C Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be on Wednesday 09/03 starting at 2p.m. The AGM is a brief meeting where all P&C positions are declared open and up for nomination. This is then followed with the normal P&C meeting (at the conclusion of the AGM).

<u>COVID Updates</u> – From today we no longer need to have children cohorted into groups. That means they will be able to congregate in the main playground instead of being restricted into cohorts. We are excited to announce that parents and visitors will soon be invited back to school for events. We do request that families still utilise the kiss and drop zone to drop off and collect kids, and of course we understand that you may need to come into the school to visit our office or the uniform shop. Our canteen will be open for students to purchase over the counter before school, at recess and lunch. We encourage families to still utilise the online ordering option or send in a lunch order with their children. The school will be sending the last of the RAT tests that the department will be supplying. You no longer need to complete RAT tests as previously. We ask if your child is displaying symptoms that you use these. Teachers will continue to wear masks this week. We will continue to encourage good hygiene, enhanced cleaning, good air flow and ventilation in learning spaces, as well as physical distancing practices.

<u>Meet the Teacher</u> - We will be holding Meet the Teacher events this week to share some organisation and processes across classes. It is really about sharing and introducing our teams. We will focus on Attendance and highlighting our whole school expectations and processes to demonstrate how we build on our Positive Behaviour for Learning (often said as PBL) through encouraging and teaching our kids and staff to be Safe, to be Respectful, Cooperative and Responsible. We will be sharing our processes for what happens if our kids are not choosing to be safe, respectful or not cooperative or responsible. We will share an overview of learning and homework expectations, and any upcoming events.

So our Stage 3 teachers, therefore Year 5 and 6 teachers and Assistant Principal, will complete an online Meet the Teacher session today, Monday 28/02. Stage 2, so our Year 3 and 4 teachers and Assistant Principal will held tomorrow, Tuesday, and Stage 1, so Year 1 and Year 2, will be on Wednesday, and our Kindy Meet the Teacher session will be on Thursday. These will all run online via zoom, from 3.15p.m. Zoom Details will shared via Schoolbag app and below for your convenience.




1B with Miss Brown
